With that in mind, we are sharing procedures that have been implemented to ensure the safety of all who enter Fairbanks Middle School.

MASKS

Because COVID 19 is spread primarily through respiratory droplets and masks have been proven to reduce the distance these droplets can travel, all staff and students will be required to wear a mask at all times while in the building unless they provide a medical exception.

ATHLETICS

When athletics / sports practices are allowed to resume, they will begin at 3:30 in order to minimize the amount of time students spend waiting for practice to start, and congregating in the process. Those who need tutoring will be allowed to arrive at practice late without repercussions provided they have documentation that they were receiving help.

ARRIVAL

- Upon arrival at Fairbanks Middle School students will report to the gym or playground then be escorted into buildings based on their respective grade.
- Students will have their temperature checked and recorded at the start of their day, as they are entering the building(s).

IN THE BUILDING

- Signs and markers will be placed throughout the campus to ensure that everyone in the building maintains an appropriate distance between themselves and others while in the hallways and classrooms.
- Classrooms and hands will be consistently sanitized throughout the school day.
- Upon the completion of the school day, students will be asked to exit the building through the nearest exit to where they end the day.
